In order to enable exchanges of young scientists between ENSEMBLES partner institutions, Research Theme 8 (RT8) is setting up a **Mobility Scholarship** program to encourage short visits. These exchange programs are aimed at sharing inter-disciplinary approaches to complex problems that arise from and are addressed by ENSEMBLES-generated research. In addition, the ENSEMBLES Mobility Scholarships are designed to enhance and highlight the impact of the ENSEMBLES community in these areas of research.

Support from ENSEMBLES can be used *inter alia* to:

- Exchange information, methodologies, model results and techniques, and general scientific experience
- Enhance existing collaboration within the ENSEMBLES community
- Present ENSEMBLES-relevant results at Workshops, Conferences and Summer Schools

Scholarships will range from **€ 5,000 to € 20,000** according to the nature of the exchange and its duration. They may be awarded either to a young scientist (pre- or post-doc) or to a group of 2 or 3 individuals (young scientists and their sponsors) at two or more ENSEMBLES partner institutions, for exchanges between these institutions.
